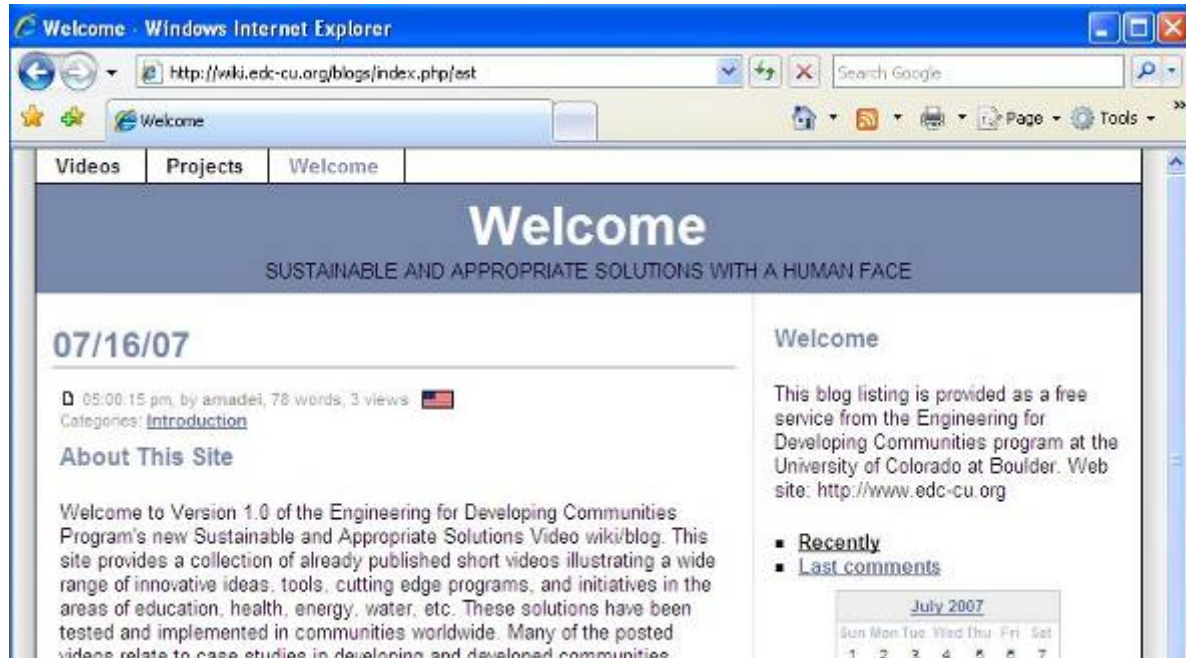


Using the EDC Wiki

Using your favorite web browser, navigate to <http://wiki.edc-cu.org>.



In Version 1.0, there are two blogs open to the public and they are LISTED AT THE TOP of this web page: "Videos" (Video Collection) and "Projects" (Student Projects).



The blogs are themselves divided into categories and sub-categories, which are listed in the right-hand column, as shown.

For each blog, click on the topic (category) of interest on the right-hand panel to filter entries matching your interest. Click on "All" (Categories) to show all published entries in all categories listed under a given blog.

Anyone can VIEW existing entries, but to obtain permission to ADD entries, you will need to register. In order to do this, click on "Register" in the "Misc" section of the right-hand column.

Click on the "Write" tab, then click on the appropriate blog name (here, only one blog option is visible: SEED).

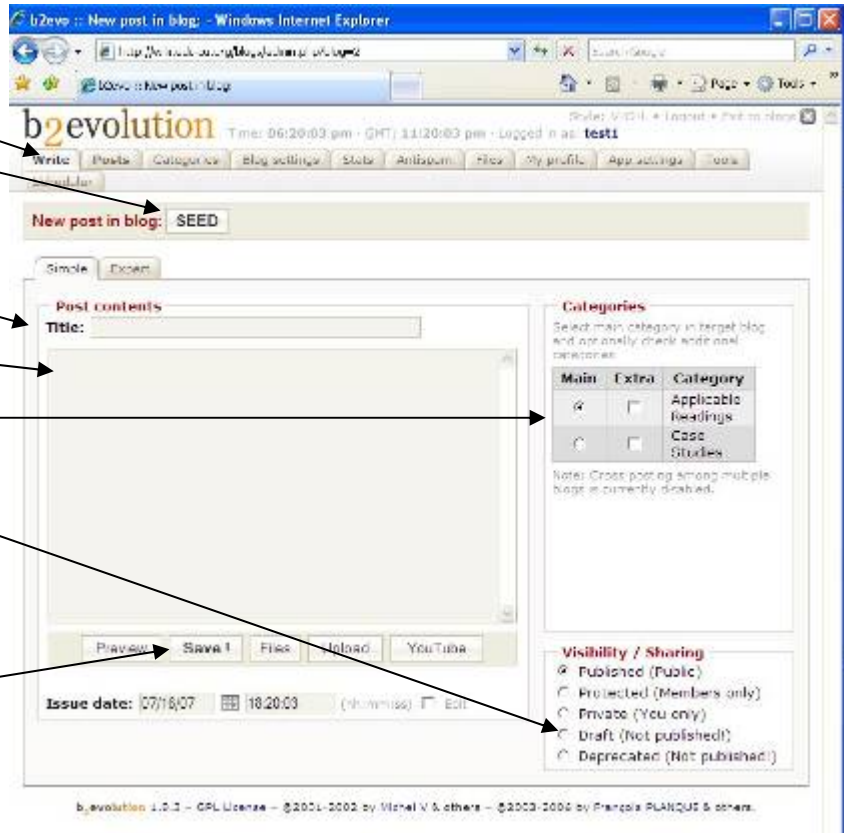
Add a title to your post.

Choose the appropriate category for your post.

Most users will have to click "draft" status in the Visibility/Sharing. Some advanced users may have access to create public posts.

Click "Save!"



5. Your posting is ready to be reviewed by the blog administrator. All entries must be appropriate to this site and will be reviewed by the site administrators before final posting.
